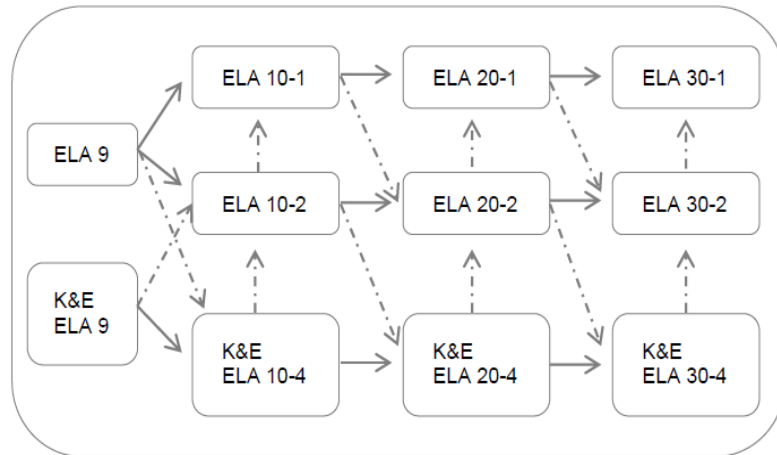


Figure 5 | Recommended English Language Arts Transfer Points

Mathematics (Math) Recommended Transfer Points

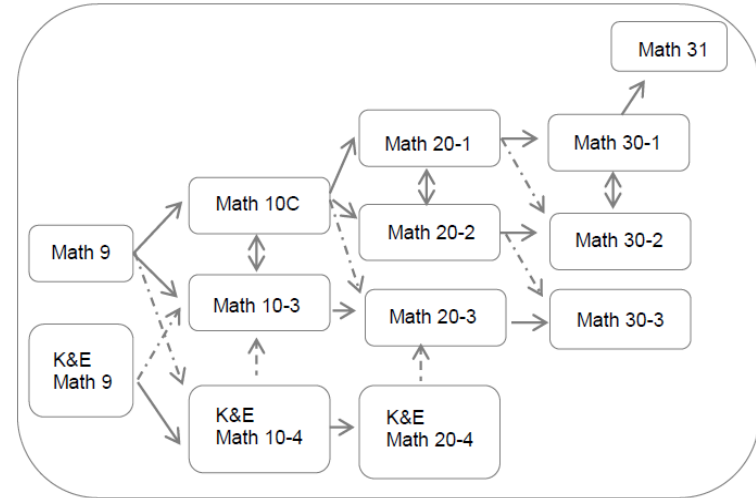


Figure 6 | Recommended Mathematics Transfer Points

Science Recommended Transfer Points

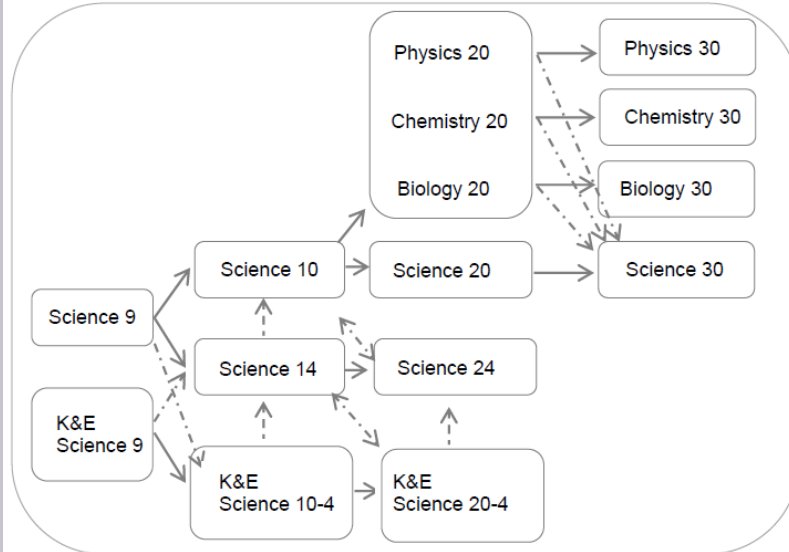


Figure 7 | Recommended Science Transfer Points

Social Studies (Social) Recommended Transfer Points

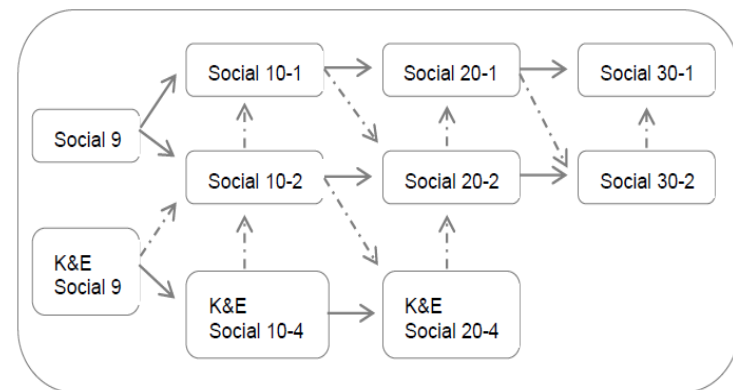


Figure 8 | Recommended Social Studies Transfer Points

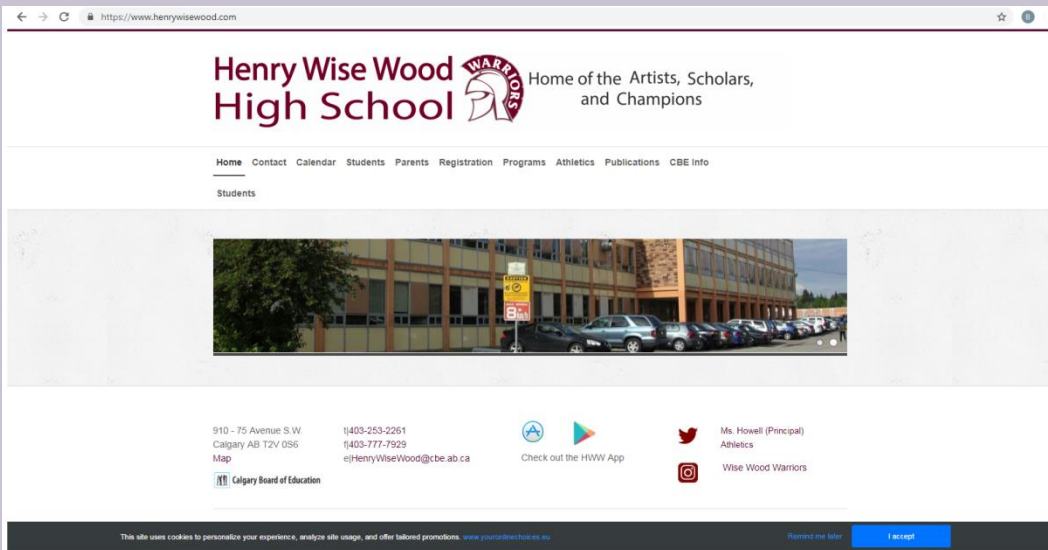

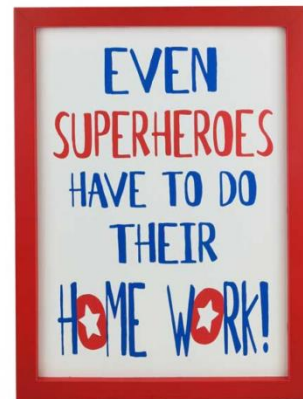


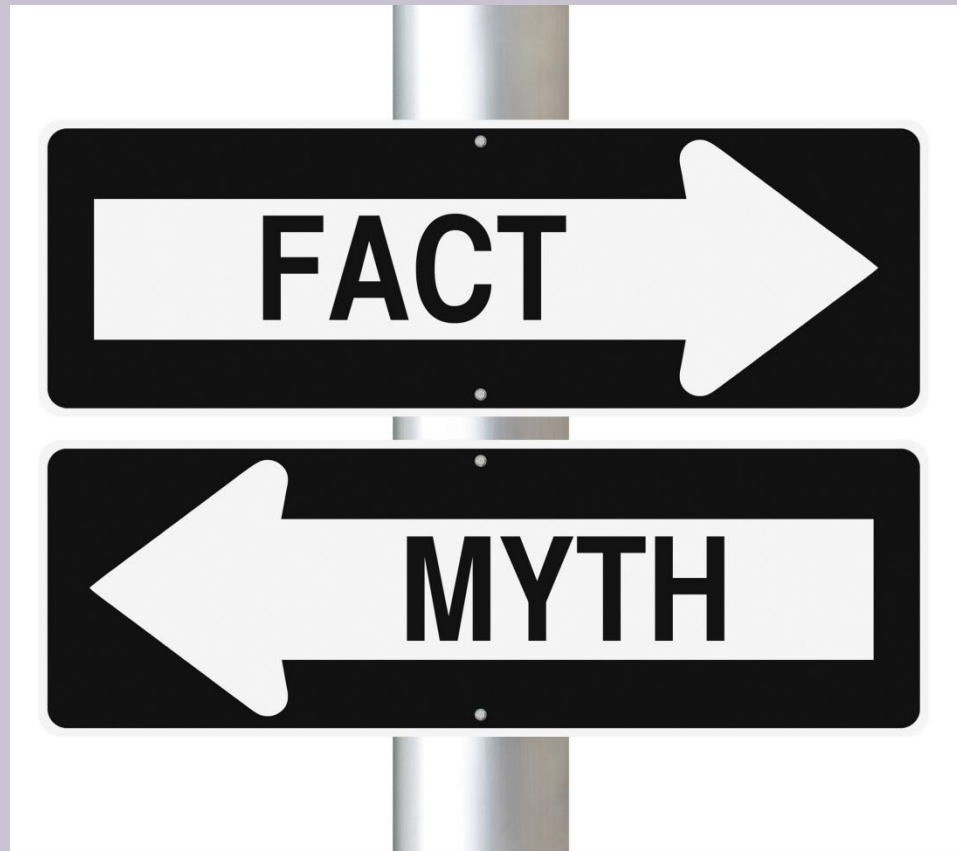
