## **Student Services:**

### ***CBE e-learn online:***

Registration for CALM in the KickStart session occurs between May 1 and June 4, 2018. The CALM course taken in this session will begin June 14, 2018 and must be completed by July 13, 2018. There is a cost of \$65 to take this online course as it is considered a summer school course.

To register for CBE e-learn courses please make an appointment with your guidance counsellor.

### ***Summer School:***

Starting Monday, April 23<sup>th</sup>, students can book an appointment with their guidance counsellor to discuss registration process for summer school through Chinook Learning and CBE e-learn. Summer school dates are from July 3 – 27, 2018 for Chinook Learning, and from July 2 – 27 (one extra day with cbe-learn). Summer school courses cost \$65 plus a \$50 textbook rental fee which will be reimbursed when the textbook is returned.
