## **Accountability Pillar Survey 2018**

### Course Request Process

January 16 – February 28

- Grade 10 and 11 students visit our website (<http://www.henrywisewood.com>) to gather course request information – under the heading “Registration”
- On February 4, Homeroom/LINK and period 3 teachers will provide course request information and a course request form to students.
- Students complete the course request form and submit to period 3 teacher by Thursday, February 7<sup>th</sup>.
- Grade 10 and 11 students who attend classes at the CTC (Career and Technology Centre) during period 3, or who have a period 3 spare are asked to come to Student Services to pick up their course request form and return it completed by Monday, February 11<sup>th</sup>.
- Starting on February 7<sup>th</sup>, counsellors will meet with students during period 3 to verify course requests.
- There is no need for students to book a planning session with a counsellor as they will meet you individually to go over your requests.

We trust students will engage in this process and take ownership in developing their educational plan. We look forward to planning the next school year.
